Tuesday 26

CASTLE OF SALAS



- * 8.30 to 9.25: Monitoring meeting for students and teachers.
- * 9.30 to 14:20: Trip to Salas, an enchanting town with a medieval essence where we will visit a tower from the 14th century which is built on the foundations of the Pre-Romanesque church of San Martin and also the Valdes Salas Palace from the 16th century.

We'll also visit the town of Cornellana to see the medieval monastery of San Salvador.

Students should take pictures to use in further activities and solve a quiz about the activity.

- * Evening: Trip to Bayo (a village nearby). We'll have lunch in Casa Campo de Petra (a hostel and restaurant) and then will prepare our own sweet bread at a local baker's.

There is also a visit to a XVII century typical Asturian house.

- * 12.00: Oviedo city centre. A stroll to walk the busiest streets and discover the most famous landmarks of the capital of Asturias: Uría Street, the Old Quarter, town hall, Parliament Palace, cathedral, Campoamor Theatre, University...
- * 14.00: Intu Asturias: a modern shopping centre where we will stop for lunch.
- * 16.00: Our trip continues to Gijón, the most populated city of Asturias, where we will show you some of its most remarkable spots (fishermen neighborhoods, palaces, port and beaches) .
- * 19.00: Return to Grado

- * 8.30 a 13.00: Workshops for mixed groups of students with a duration of 1.30 hours each. All students will go through the three of them.
 - Kahoot: students create a quiz with questions related to the activities that have been carried out during the previous days.
 - Storytelling: students create a comic based in one of the sites they have visited.
 - Celtic Knots: Asturias has a strong Celtic tradition; in this workshop students will create crafts with these symbols that were used to decorate weapons, tools or even their own bodies.
